Mr. Boggs reviewed claims and payroll and asked for approval. Tom Craft made a motion to approve claims and payroll, as presented. Todd Hoffman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Boggs reviewed the Financial Report for the Board.

Old Business: Mr. Boggs presented for approval an addition to School Board Policy regarding an Outside Activities of Staff policy. Dave O'Brien made a motion to approve the addition to School Board Policy. Todd Hoffman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Boggs presented the master calendar for the 2015-206 school year for approval. A few visitors and teachers were in attendance to voice their concerns or support for the proposed calendar. Mark Wise, Pam Smith and Julie Canada were all concerned about the start day and the short notice given to parents. Kayla Rassi explained the extra four days would make a huge difference in standardized test results. It was noted that this calendar was prepared with input from the Teacher's Association and, overall, teachers wanted extra time before ISTEP. Dave O'Brien made a motion to approve the 2015-2016 master calendar. Todd Hoffman seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Tom Craft made the motion to accept the KEYS grants awarded and Stan Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Miller, Mr. Backus, and Mr. Hutton presented changes to student and staff handbooks for initial consideration. Final approval of the handbook changes from the Board will be obtained in May.

Mr. Conley presented the TVSC Wellness Policy for the Board's approval. Tom Craft made a motion to approve the wellness policy. Dave O'Brien seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Conley presented an overview of the social studies textbook selection process. He explained that teachers and parent representatives participated in the Social Studies Textbook Caravan in South Bend where they were able to preview textbooks from several companies. After the Caravan, textbook companies presented to staff members as well as high school students. Mr. Conley reviewed the textbooks selected by the textbook adoption committee, explaining that each textbook has a digital component available. Tom Craft made the motion to adopt the social studies textbooks presented and Stan Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Conley presented the TVSC Food Service Code of Conduct for initial consideration. Final approval of the code of conduct from the Board will be obtained in May.

Mr. Hutton, Assistant Principal at TVHS, provided a brief overview of the contract with Bowen Center for the Student Assistance Counseling Program. This program will allow for Bowen to provide two counseling sessions to each high school student at no cost. Todd Hoffman made the motion to approve the contract with Bowen Center and Tom Craft seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Boggs presented the tree planting project at TVHS. He explained that trees native to Indiana will be planted along the east and south sides of TVHS. Tom Craft made the motion to approve the tree planting project and Stan Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Boggs presented the partnership between United Way of Kosciusko County and TVSC to bring Kindergarten Countdown Camp to Mentone and Akron Elementary Schools. This camp, which is financially supported by the United Way, provides kindergarten orientation to future kindergarten students who have not participated in preschool. Stan Miller made the motion to approve Kindergarten Countdown Camp and Dave O'Brien seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Miller and Mrs. Wilks presented plans for a Kindergarten Readiness Center at Mentone Elementary. This preschool would service up to 20 students per day and will be modeled after a preschool at Claypool Elementary. The goal of the pilot preschool program is to provide a resource to parents in the Mentone area that is not currently available and to retain students within TVSC. Todd Hoffman made the motion to approve the Mentone Readiness Center and Tom Craft seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Madison Miller, student representative, reported that the TVHS prom will take place on May 9, 2015. She also wanted to remind everyone of the birthday celebration for TVHS on June 20, 2015.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
