Dyslexia

Indiana has passed a new law (SEA 217) requiring schools to screen all students in grades K, 1, and 2 for characteristic traits of dyslexia beginning July 1, 2019. Schools do not diagnose dyslexia. If a student has these traits, it is up to the parents to determine if they want to seek an outside evaluation. The school and district is not responsible for the cost of diagnosis.

Districts must report annually the number of students screened, the number of students at risk for the diagnosis, and the number of students with a diagnosis of dyslexia.
